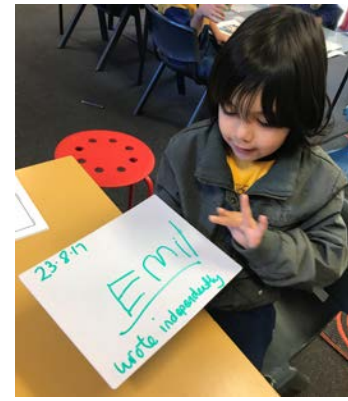
Every Thursday the children are learning cultural music and dance with "Song room" in the school hall.

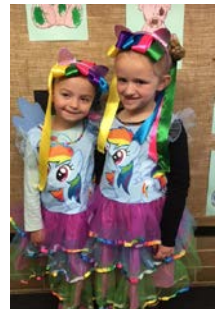
Playground Initiative – Plastic outdoor chairs needed!
