Acting Principal's Report

It has been so lovely having all our students back at school. We have been extremely impressed with how well they have come back and settled into our school routines.

In order to keep everyone safe we will continue with the following until further notice:

- Cohorts of students staying together
- Staff allocated to cohorts
- Marked playground spaces for specific grades to access
- Staggered finish times (Preschool, Kinder, Year 1 & Year 2)
- No visitors permitted onsite
- Online payments only being accepted through the front office (uniforms etc.)
- Additional school and classroom cleaning throughout the day
- Hand sanitising and washing throughout the day

All students must have the following each day:

- Lunch
- Recess
- Drink bottle

There is no canteen or breakfast club available until further notice. We are asking parents and carers to complete a Canteen Survey to decide if the canteen can re-open. The link is in this newsletter.

Health Concerns

Students who are unwell or have any flu-like symptoms (runny nose, cough, fever, sore throat) must not be sent to school. If we have a concern about your child you wil be contacted to come and collect them. A student who is sent home with flu-like syptoms needs to have a negative Covid test in order to return.

Drop Off and Pick Up

We have been working hard to make sure that this will be a safe process for everyone and this will mean some changes to how students enter and leave our school. Our biggest priority is to minimise the number of families waiting to drop off or collect students.

There will be 3 gates open during drop off and pick up:

- Front gate
- Back gate
- Side gate (basketball court) Lincluden Pl

I am asking parents and carers to do the following when dropping off and picking up their child:

- follow the physical distancing advice for their local area and avoid gathering outside school gates
- remain outside our school grounds
- adhere to mask-wearing requirements in accordance with the Public Health Order
- remain in the car if possible when dropping off staff will be at the gate to greet your child

- Preschool staggered start and pick up times
- Kindergarten pick up at 2.45pm
- Year 1 pick up at 2.50pm
- Year 2 pick up at 2.55pm

Changes to Pick-Up times

To decrease the number of people at the gates in the afternoon we are keeping the change to the pickup times for our Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 students.

- Kindergarten pick up time 2.45pm
- Year 1 pick up time 2.50pm
- Year 2 pick up time 2.55pm

Families that have students in additional grades will continue to be collected at the new pick up time ie. if you have a child in Kinder and Year 4 both students will leave at 2.45pm until further notice.
