#### **Preschool Graduation**

Our preschool educators have been busy organising the Graduation Ceremony for our youngest students. They will be held on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> Dec for our Mon-Tues group and Friday 10<sup>th</sup> Dec for our Thurs-Fri group. #### **Presentation Day**

Due to the current Department of Education guidelines only 1 fully vaccinated parent or carer of students in Yr 3-6 who are receiving a perpetual award or leadership badge will be able to attend. This will generally be a parent or carer whose child is in Yr 5 or Yr 6. If your child is receiving one of these awards you will receive an invitation in the coming week.

We are so pleased that our Year 6 Farewell is able to go ahead this year. It is being held at Campbelltown Golf Club on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> Dec starting at 6pm. Students will be receiving an invitation and we are looking forward to all students being able to attend. There will be no fee for our students, with our wonderful P&C providing a donation to the school to cover the cost. There are a number of guidelines that we must follow for this event to occur. These are:

- All students must be accompanied by a fully vaccinated adult member of their household who
  must sign the student into the Campbelltown Golf Club using the QR code. The student is then
  able to be left in the care of the supervising staff.
- The parent or carer **MUST** remain at the Campbelltown Golf Club during the event with the parent or carer returning to collect their child at the end of the farewell.
- The parent or carer must follow the venue's COVID-safe practices when checking in and out.




# **Library News**
