Intensive Learning Support Program (ILSP)

This year our school received funding to support students returning to school after 2 years of disrupted learning due to Covid-19. Students from Preschool – Year 6 have received additional support in a variety of ways, including small group interventions, speech therapy and additional School Learning Support Officer (SLSO) support. Small group interventions have focused on numeracy and literacy skills. This program commenced in 2021 and we are pleased that it has been extended into Semester 1 for 2023.

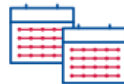




SCHOOL OFFICE



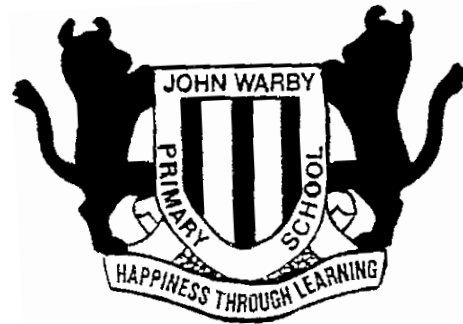
