Intensive Learning Support Program (ILSP)

This year our school received funding to support students returning to school after 2 years of disrupted learning due to Covid-19. Students from Preschool – Year 6 have received additional support in a variety of ways, including small group interventions, speech therapy and additional School Learning Support Officer (SLSO) support. Small group interventions have focused on numeracy and literacy skills. This program commenced in 2021 and we are pleased that is has been extended into Semerster 1 for 2023.



Eftpos machine closes at 2.00pm daily and no transactions or purchases can be made after this time.




HOW TO MAKE AN ONLINE PAYMENT

Our school can now take online payments. Payments can be made online on our school website – https://johnwarby-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/




1. This is an example of the screens that you will be presented with when making payments. Please complete each screen and click on Next Section after filling in fields indicated by the arrow.


